Faith and Life Class Topics

Kick off the new year by joining us for Faith and Life classes in January. We meet at 11:15 am after fellowship time in either the Centennial Room or the Parlor

January 6: View and discuss the second Great Courses DVD presentation by Professor Amy-Jill Levine on "the Old Testament, or Tanakh, (that) was written in ancient Israel over 1,000 years by many authors. What can this book teach us about the ancient Israelites? What does our faith find in new scholarly understanding? As scripture or as the most influential piece of literature ever written, this book is a source of constant wonder, inspiration, and intrigue." The topic is "Adam and Eve", although Professor Levine addresses events found throughout Genesis.

January 13: Response to today's sermon lectionary passages, specifically Luke 3:15–17, 21–22 and the topic "Saved to Serve the Whole World: A Baptism Empowers Mission". This is an excellent opportunity to delve further into scripture and discuss what it means to us today. Questions for contemplation will be provided during the session.

January 20: Pastor Kevin will present on the topic of "The Way Forward" in his first monthly "Conversations with Kevin" series that will take place on the third Sunday of every month. This is a terrific way to stay in touch with our mission, "To love God and Neighbor."

January 27: Back by popular demand, David Page will lead a meditation session, a fulfilling way to quiet our busy minds and get in touch with the spirit within.
